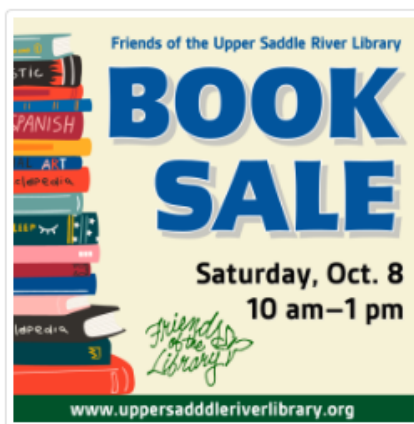
Arlene Fretz sent an email to the church office thanking everyone for their kind notes and prayers following her surgery and recovery.

Family Promise is able to empower homeless working families and those at-risk of homelessness to become self-sufficient by providing temporary housing and personalized support, including job training, financial education, life skills, transportation, childcare, enrichment for children, and more. Family Promise also addresses hunger in our community through the nightly Walk-In Dinner Program, which since 1991 has served more than 1/2 million meals to our neighbors in need.

Holland Christian Home, founded 127 years ago to serve the elderly in a Christ-centered homestyle atmosphere—small enough to care for each resident individually, but large enough to serve in a professional and beautiful setting. They ask for your prayers as they need many more applicants to get back to a healthy census following the pandemic.
